Hello Stafford,

What is the SEDC?

The Stafford Economic Development Corporation was established to develop business, jobs, and quality-of-life projects that can make a difference to our citizens and community. The corporation is funded by a 1/2 cent sales tax that is considered restricted funds by state law. These funds can only be spent if they fall into certain categories by law. These laws keep us focused on what the tax was intended for and not deviate to other expenditures.

City Council appoints board members who then select the board officers by vote. Board members meet every fourth Tuesday of the month and would be pleased if you attend in person or watch by television or live streaming.

Some of our past, current and future projects are:

- South Main/90A beautification and primary corridor project.
- Provide incentives for the redevelopment of the Texas instrument property to obtain something other than warehouses and office buildings.
- Extension of Cash Road to Kirkwood.
- Replacement and redesign of Pike Road.
- Installation of license plate readers in commercial areas to attract business development and provide enhanced crime prevention and monitoring.

- Developing a street maintenance project and moving ahead on drainage projects in areas where we can.
- Replacement of the drinking water fountains in the city parks is being discussed and reviewed.
