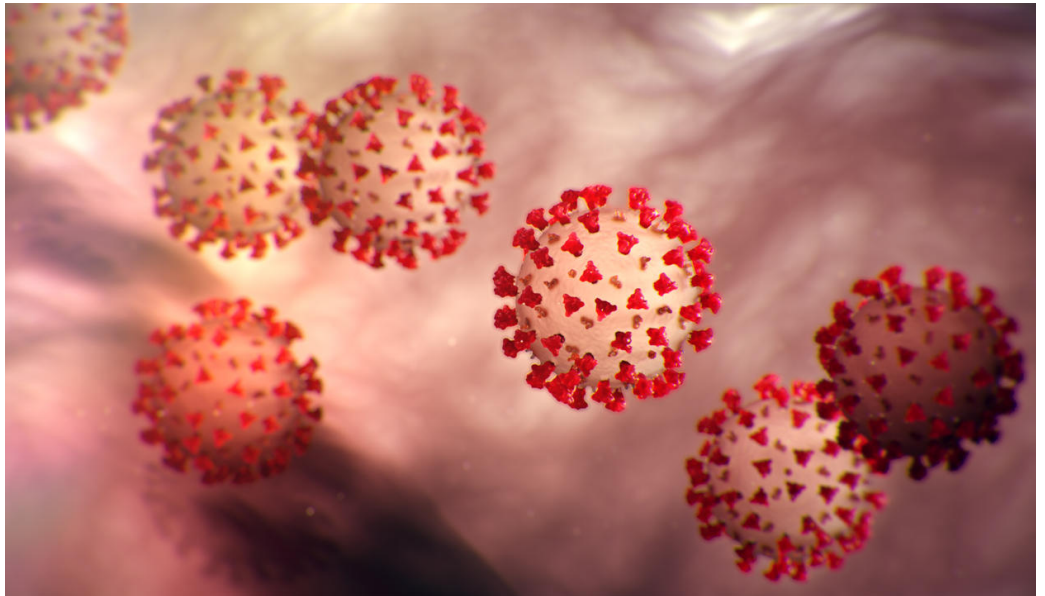

Monday, 3-16-20 Coronavirus Update



From Stafford Office of Emergency Management

- 3-SFD personnel are NOT symptomatic and 14-day exposure quarantine period ends tomorrow, March 17.
- CDC Atlanta results have still not been received on Stafford patient
- 2ND Possible case in Stafford determined to NOT fit COVID-19 patient profile

- Case count:
 - US 3,000
 - Texas: 57
 - Fort Bend Co.: 9
 - Harris Co: 10
 - Stafford: 1

- SMSD: In an effort to support the nation's need to flatten the curve of the COVID-19 pandemic, Dr. Robert Bostic has announced Stafford MSD will extend the suspension of normal district operations through Friday, April 10, 2020.

- Tonight's School Board meeting postponed until further notice

- STAFFORD Municipal Court Cases (courtroom appearances for arraignment, pretrial, judge trial and jury trial) have been rescheduled beginning March 17-31, 2020 and will be reset to a later date.

- Stafford Centre and Stafford Civic Center will be closed for all engagements beginning Monday, March 16 through Tuesday, March 31, 2020.

- HCC has extended this week's spring break at least 2 days more days to ready the campus for possible conversion to on-line classes

- Houston and Harris Co.: Starting Tuesday at 8 a.m. and for 15 days until extended or otherwise revised, every restaurant in the Harris county must offer only delivery, pick-up and drive-thru service and close for sit-down meals. All bars and clubs must close. Stafford and Fort Bend have not made that directive at this time.
